


Bradford Street c1960 - Some of its lost Georgian buildings on left including (lower down) that of the proposed nail manufactory disputed by Richard and Thomas.



Richard's first employers (Image Ancestry - Wrightson's Directory 1818)












A nail machine seen in operation in 1844 at the Britannia Nail Manufactory . (The Penny Magazine, Vol. XIII, December 1844 p.504.)




